Why hasn't Mayor and Council set a date for a SPECIAL ELECTION to fill former Council Member Thomas Callaway's VACANT seat? Rumor has it that Mayor and Council are trying to find a legal loophole to appoint former Council Member to the seat he resigned from in order to run for House District 62 seat in the May 24, 2022, Primary. According to the Charter:

- Sec. 3-104. - Special election

In the event that the office of mayor or any councilmember shall become vacant for any cause, the city council shall order a special election to fill the balance of the unexpired term of such official; provided, however, that, if the vacancy occurs within 12 months of the expiration of the term of that office, the city council shall appoint a successor for the remainder of the term.

Former Council Member resigned with more than 22 months left of his elected term that expires on December 31, 2023. Mayor and Council have had ample time to call for a Special Election that would have coincided with Primary Run-Off date set for June 2022.

Why hasn't Mayor and Council told the residents that the City has voted to have the Downtown Development Authority to secure Bonds up to $\$ 14$ million for the renovation of the City Auditorium? The City is over its head in adding debt for the residents to pay off.
